## CHEMFEST 2022

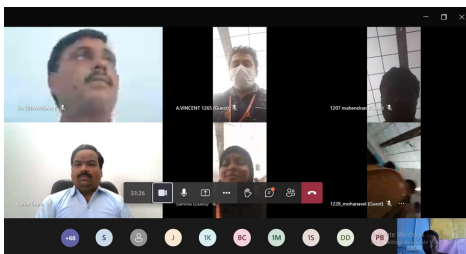


## NATIONAL WORKSHOP ON DATA ANALYTICS USING ADVANCED EXCEL

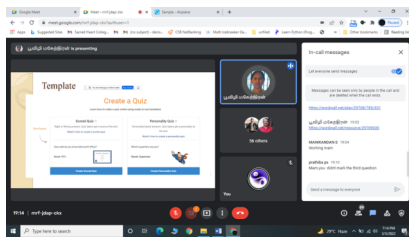
# SPECIAL LECTURE ON LOVE AND INTIMACY

# NATIONAL WORKSHOP ON ONLINE QUIZ TOOLS



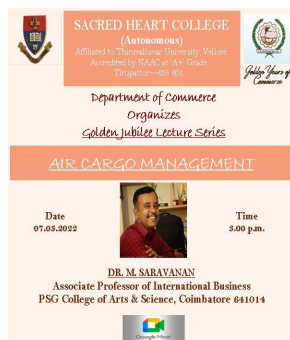

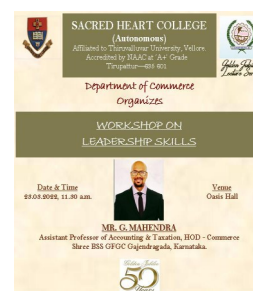
## WORKSHOP SERIES LECTURE ON “AIR CARGO MANAGEMENT”

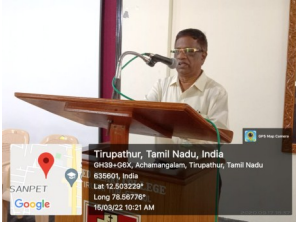

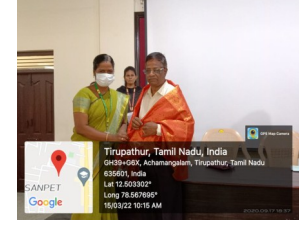




# INVITED TALK ON NEED FOR ENVIRONMENTAL AWARENESS

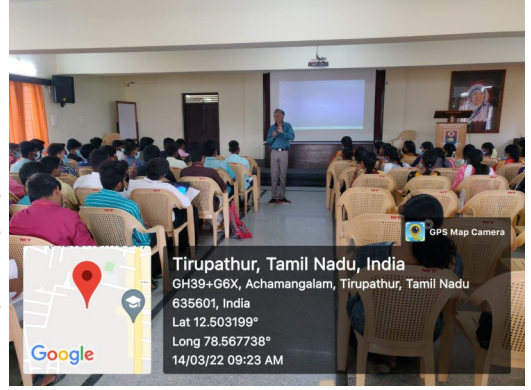

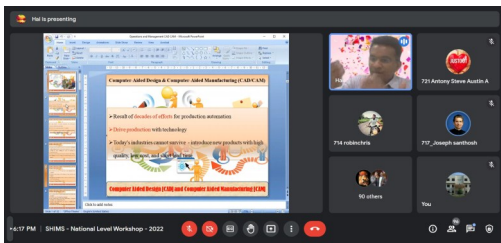
