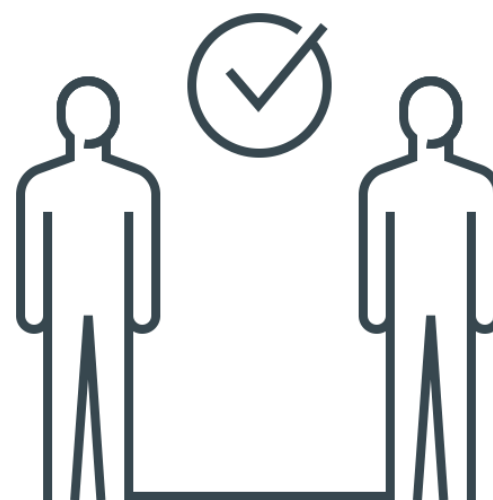

A Series of Webinars and E-Quizzes by the Department of Physics

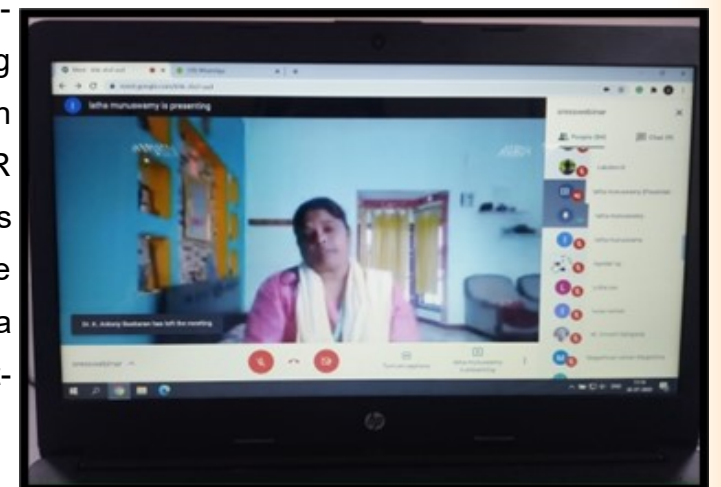

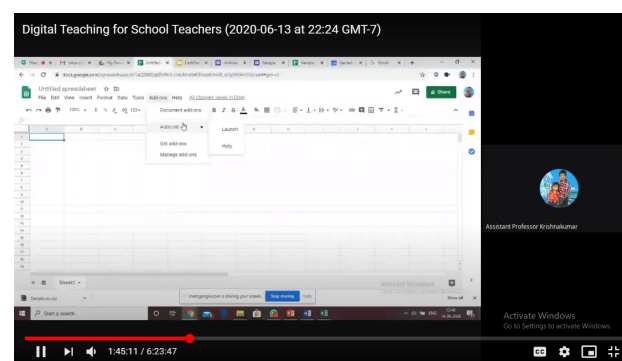
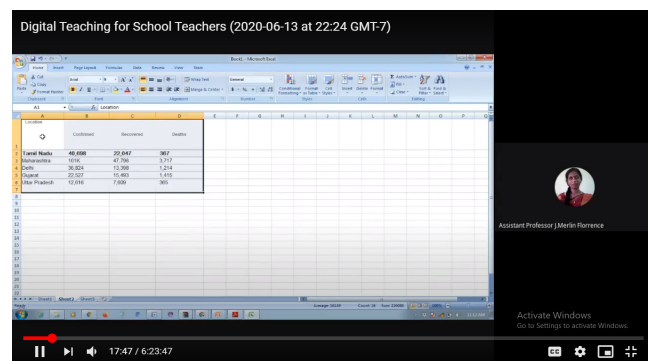
Stay Protective and Be Productive-Awareness Programme

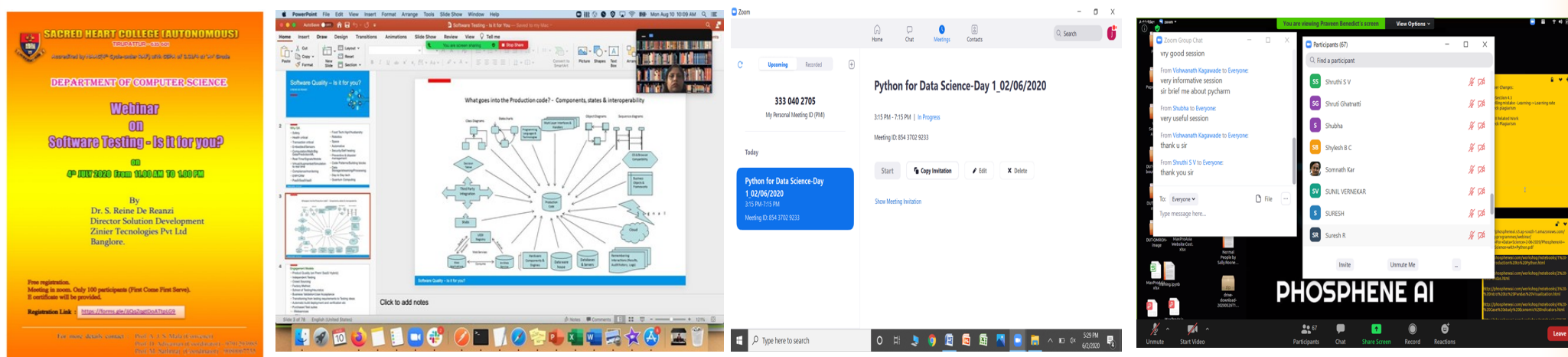
A Series of Webinars by The Department of Social Work

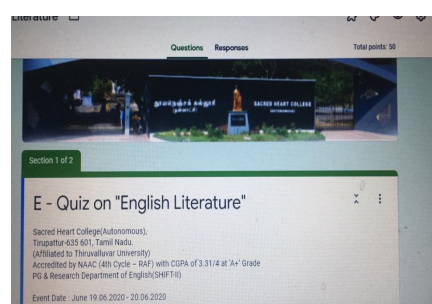


International Virtual Conference IVC 2020

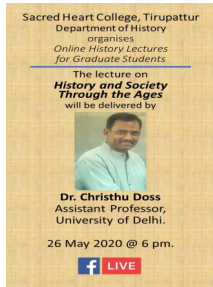
International Webinar on Recent Trends in Information Sciences
