# **Legendry Salesian Educator Rev.Fr. Joseph Murphy Remembered on His 50<sup>th</sup> Death Anniversary**



On 14 November, 2021 the Salesian Community of Sacred Heart College, Tirupattur and the well wishers of Rev. Fr. Joseph Murphy gathered to remember and pay tribute on the 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary of his death. The young Salesians and college students carried Rev.Fr. Murphy's portrait in procession and installed it near the college office. Rev. Fr. Murphy's former students, among who were senior Salesians and faculty members who had served the college under his leader-

ship joined the solemn Eucharistic celebration offered in his memory. Delivering the homily Rev.Fr. K. J. Louis SDB, former student, remembered him as a great human being, an outstanding educator and loyal son of Don Bosco. In his welcome address Rev. Dr. John Alexander SDB, Rector said: True to the epitaph inscribed on his tombstone Though dead, he still speaks (Hebrew 11:4), he continues to live in the hearts of the Salesians and young people in the campus through the values of hard work, kindness, primacy of God and love for the poor that were so dear to him. He is the author of the College motto: Ready for every good work. Later, speaking at his tomb, Fr. Joseph Berchmans, former student recalled: "standing at the very same spot in the cemetery exactly fifty years ago, I was privileged to bid farewell to Fr. Murphy through a funeral oration on behalf of the young Salesians and students". Born on 4 April 1920, in Newcastle, England, he arrived in India in 1938. He was just 18 years old when he arrived here as a newly professed Salesian. He completed his Salesian formation and ecclesiastical studies at Tirupattur and was ordained as a priest in 1948. After getting academically quali-

fied in Mumbai University, in 1953 he was appointed Vice Principal of Sacred Heart College which had received provisional affiliation in 1951 with Rev. Fr. John Med as the first Principal. Rev. Fr. Murphy was appointed Principal of the college in 1954. In the next nine years, he nurtured it and set it on the road to academic distinction and excellence in the University of Madras. The College community also paid tribute to two other



Salesians, Rev. Fr. Vincent Durairaj and Bro. Joseph Das, who had served the college with distinction and passed away to eternity recently.



## Webinar Series by the Department of Business Administration



The function started with a hymn to Holy Spirit by the Campus Ministry team.


Fr. Maria Antonyraj SDB, the
