After the discussions the following decisions were made regarding the UG English Literature syllabus such as:

- In Chaucer and Elizabethan Age, two units are allotted for poetry. Hence a couple of non-detailed poetry can be included. In unit IV one more non-detailed prose can be added. In unit V more representatives of the age can be included as non-detailed. In the reference section Nair, Ramachandran K R. *Literary Forms* can be removed. Edward Alfred 's *History of English Literature* can be added. Abrams M H. *A Glossary of Literary Terms* recent edition should be included.
- In 18th Century English Literature paper some literature pieces can be included in Unit I as introduction of an age alone cannot be a unit. In Unit II *Pamela* can be substituted with some other work as it is heavy for UG students to read it.
- In Literary Forms paper no changes were suggested

- In Social History of England paper the order of the reference book need to be changed. G.M. Trevelyan should come first and. A.G. Xavier should be in the second place.
- In the paper Romantic Age under Unit I, few more representative authors can be included. In Unit IV *Pride and Prejudice* can be added in detailed section and one more work can be added for non-detailed. Authors should arranged in the right manner. Another work can be added in Unit V as non-detailed.
- In the paper Epics in English, in Unit IV instead of Lord Byron's *Don Juan* some other epic can be included.
- In History of English Literature paper, Edward Albert's book can be the prescribed text. Major writers and minor writers from the text can be included in the units.
- In the paper History of English Language, one of the reference book "History of English Language" by A C Baugh can be included.
- In the paper Major English Tragedies *Dr.Faustus* can be removed and *Edward II* can be included.
- In History of English Literature –II paper, under Unit –V British authors alone can be added do not add American or Canadian authors. Recent books published by Oxford Publication on History of English Language can be introduced for reference.
- In Indian Writing in English paper along with introduction, poetry of Unit II can be added to unit-I, unit II will be prose, unit III will be short story and unit IV will be fiction. In unit III R.K.Narayan has to be changed. Under unit V some other works can be introduced. Some of the pre independent writers can be introduced.
- In Phonetics paper, the given paper accepted without change.
- In the paper Victorian Age instead of the novel *Middlemarch*, *Silas Marner* can be suggested as it is heavy at UG level.
- In 20th Century English Literature paper Albert Camus can be removed. From Unit III *Pygmalion* can be removed and included in the paper Literature and Film. Under unit V *Mrs. Dalloway* and *Lord of the Flies* can be included in Children's Literature paper.
- In the paper Literary Criticism I, chapter selection should be made in *On the Sublime*. *Apology for Poetry* can be replaced with *Preface to Shakespeare*. In *Preface to Lyrical Ballads* selection of chapters should be made.
- In Indian Writing in English –II paper contemporary Indian writers can be included in poetry. Translated works need not be included instead original Indian writings can be introduced. *Midnight's Children* can be prescribed for PG students not at UG level. One male writer and one female writer can be introduced in fiction. The suggested short story can be changed and YouTube video lectures can be included under references.
- In Commonwealth Literature paper Ambai's *Wrestling*, Yann Martel's *Life of pi* and Chinua Achebe can be changed. Some pep talks can be included in references.
- In Literature and Film paper chapter division should be reworked into, Introduction to Hollywood, Introduction to Bollywood, Technology of Film making, Reviews and Movies. Topics should be more specific, Blog Busters can also be introduced. Paper need to be reworked.

- In Women's Writing paper George Eliot is repeated it can be changed. Modern writers can be introduced. Ambai can be removed. The novel *Bitter Chocolate* by Pinki Virani on CSA can be introduced.

1. The meeting started with a short prayer by Dr. G. Prakashraj. The Chairman of the Board Dr. K. A. Maria John Joseph welcomed all the members to the annual meeting of the Board of Studies in Commerce. He specially welcomed Dr. A. Marcus and CA. T Pothimadhavan the subject experts, and Dr. S. Sreedharan the University Nominee

and thanked them for their availability in spite of the difficulties caused by the Corona Pandemic.

- 2. The chairman of the board then briefed the members of the agenda of the meeting and requested the external members to share their suggestions. The HOD explained the need for changing the course on Business Organisation. He felt the course can be further enriched by focussing on the environment in which the business operates. Accordingly the Environmental aspect of Business is to be given weightage. He also read out the syllabi for the course and requested the members share their views. Dr. Marcus felt that the syllabus looks good and enriching however it may prove too heavy for the first year students given their background. Dr. Sreedharan also shared a similar view. They opined that if the course can be offered in such a way to make it easy to follow for the students then the same may be approved. The HOD asserted that the subject could be made easy through proper medium of instruction and study material and that the subject will provide a good platform for the rest of the courses. Following the discussion the syllabi for the course was approved.
- 3. The HOD then asked Prof. Devi to explain to the board the need for shifting the HRM course from subject skill list to core list. Prof. Devi explained that by bringing the HRM course to the core list, the students will be able to study the course which is very essential at B.Com. level. All the members of the board agreed with her view and it was decided to move the course from elective list to core list and to offer it in the sixth semester.

In order to accommodate the change it was decided to combine the business law course in the sixth semester with the company law course in the third semester by appropriately renaming it as 'Mercantile Law', to be offered in the third semester.

The Board decided to bring 'Social Entrepreneurship' as an elective paper in the place of HRM and the syllabi for 'Human Resource Management' and 'Social Entrepreneurship' was also approved.

- 4. The Board unanimously agreed and reinstated the importance of offering the computerised accounting course for the third years. In fact this paper and the corresponding syllabus was approved and passed in the Board of studies and academic council meeting respectively in the year 2019 itself. The paper could not be offered to the students due to non-availability of lab facility. Hence the Board request the management to provide computer lab facility so that at least the present students would get an opportunity to study the paper.
- 5. It was unanimously decided to have GST filing practices instead of Indirect Tax filing practices as a Certificate Course.
- 6. The HOD shared his thoughts on including the internship as a mandatory two credit course for the students to give them a practical hands-on experience on the functioning of businesses. The external members said that many of the colleges have such a course in their syllabus and that it would be a good value addition to the syllabus. Following discussions it was decided to offer it as such and the students would be required to go on a three week internship during their fourth semester

- vacation and will be evaluated based on the internship report submitted by them after returning in the fifth semester.
- 7. The Chairman of the Board requested Dr. G. Devi to propose a formal vote of thanks and with the Vote of thanks the meeting of the Board came to an end. The chairman of the board personally thanked all the members for their presence and contribution for enriching the syllabus.
