John Bosco is an extraordinary man of God. He is the founder of the Salesian Congregation. He was a great educator of the young, Builder of churches, intermediary between the Pope and the Italian State in very troubled times, confidante of Popes, zealous missionary who sent out eleven missionary expeditions, author, writer, a great Marian Apostle and above all a Saint and teacher of holiness. A shepherd boy from a village, orphaned of father when he was two years old, he experienced poverty and had his own share of domestic problems. Young John had to go round begging to pay for his early education. At the age of nine, Jesus the Good Shepherd in a dream indicated to him, his life-mission namely, to work for the salvation of the young and educate "not through blows, but through kindness and persuasion". With Mother Mary as his Mother and Help, he began with an orphan boy, the first of hundreds of abandoned children he was to care for, providing them food, shelter, religious instruction and innocent recreation. He faced abandonment by fellow workers, was considered by some a disgrace to clerical decorum a threat to society, abnormal. There were attempts to assassination, years of misunderstanding with his own ecclesiastical authorities. It needed the weight of the Pope's authority and miracles to have the religious Society he wished to found, approved. He was an idealist, creator of solid realities, now a canonized saint. The Church recognized him as the Father and friend of poor youth.
