- 4. Few Suggestions were given by the experts on the contents of the syllabus,
  - Latest books can be used for the all the subjects.
  - Reference books must be 4 for all the subjects.
  - Unit contents of Principles of Compiler Design can be maximized.
  - Advanced Java Programming can be changed as Java Programming.
  - Unit contents of Security System and cryptography and network security subjects should be checked.
  - Sanboxing and intrusion should be included in security system.
  - Text book for Machine Learning was suggested by the subject expert (Author name: Subramanian Chandramouli).
  - Mathematics paper should be included in the curriculum and it can be handled by the department staff itself.
  - B.Sc (CT/IT) should be removed from the regulations.
  - Virtualization should be added as one unit in cloud computing.
  - Programming in Python unit IV and V can be reworked.
  - Xamarin can be introduced in Mobile application.
  - Open Source Technologies subject content should be reworked. Postgre SQL can be added instead of MYSQL.
