POST GRADUATE DIPLOMA IN HUMAN RESOURCE MANAGEMENT

PAPER II: HUMAN RESOURCE MANAGEMENT AND INFORMATION SYSTEM

- ERP Modules in unit 5 was added.

PAPER IV: INDUSTRIAL RELATIONS AND EMPLOYEE WELFARE

- Role of state government was refined as “Role of appropriate government” in unit 1.
- Removed Trade union to avoid duplications and renamed the title of unit 2 as “Trade union concepts- evolution and growth”
- “Settlement machinery” replaced in the place of “Government machinery” in unit 2.
- Labour and welfare fund was clubbed together in unit 3 as Labor welfare fund.

- Awareness about Health and Safety Standards was included in unit 4.
- Board recommended refining BPO as “CPO” in Unit 5.
