- Syllabi and Evaluation pattern for UG.

- Instead of the paper Monetary Economics-II, Marketing Management paper to be introduced in the sixth semester.
- Principles of Economics-I and Principles of Economics-II will be clubbed together as Principles of Economics.
- Instead of the paper Principles of Economics-II, Entrepreneurial Economics paper to be introduced for Allied B. Com, during the second semester.
- The syllabus was fine tuned based on the outcome based curriculum format framing the course objectives and outcomes mapping with different cognitive levels.
