The following are the business transacted:

- The revised syllabus of 2021-2022 was brought for discussion. As only the first semester
 was completed and the second semester is in progress and only one third of the portion is
 completed, suggestions were welcomed from only the course teachers.
- One of the student representatives suggested that the syllabus for Semester -I of UG
 English consist of the four Part-II General English only, so papers like Literary Forms
 could be introduced to give an outline of English Literature at the first semester itself.
- The course teachers of Business Communication suggested to revise the content of the book to suit the need and progression level of the first semester students, since the students of other disciplines are studying only in their fourth semester. It is also

suggested to shift Business Communication-Book-IV into the second semester for B.A. English students.

The course teachers of Literary Forms felt that the content of the syllabus is heavy for the level of the first-year students. The students are not able to comprehend and retain many terms and also the difficulty for the staff to complete the portion. So, it was decided to have a common understanding regarding the detailed and non-detailed topics of the paper, Literary Forms, between the course teachers of both Shift-I and Shift-II. With regard to the external question paper setting, at the time of scrutiny the course teacher could modify the question papers with the consent of the chairperson to suit to the level of the students.

General suggestions and discussions

- The subject expert expressed his appreciation for the idea of bringing the four Part-II
 English into the first semester to give an intensive training on the English
 Language. He found this as very new and unique.
- The subject expert suggested the course teachers to review the syllabus of TRB,
 UGC and other competitive exams and include some of them into the syllabus. So that it might help the students to crack their competitive exams.
- The course teachers were asked to prepare their Course Outcomes by including Blooms Taxonomy at all levels. The teams for preparing the Program Specific Outcomes were also formed.
