


Department of English (UG)

Since it is a recently revised curriculum, only the courses offered in the fourth semester were taken for discussion.



















- In the Third Semester, the course teachers of Major English Tragedies- EN414 expressed that the syllabus is good, could be continued as it is. For the next revision Unit-I *Edward II* could be replaced with some English Tragedies, since the theme is difficult for UG II years to comprehend.
- The course teachers of History of English Literature-II: EN415 expressed that the syllabus is good. Since it is divided and offered as two papers, they were able to deliver the content and students were able to comprehend the representative authors.
- The course teachers of Indian English Writings- Pre Independence Era: EN416 felt that the division of pre-independence and post- independent in Indian English Writings is good and expressed that could be accepted without any suggestion.
- Phonetics course teachers expressed that the content of the syllabus is very good but when it comes to testing, equal weight age could be given to the application of the theory they have learnt. The University Nominee cautioned that application part of the paper may increase the difficulty level of the students and equal weight age may not be possible.

- Internship policies for UG & PG were presented for discussion. Subject Expert enquired the about the desired places for internships. After the discussion the Chairman of the boards promised to prepare the final policy document incorporating all the suggestions elucidated by the members of the board.
- Suggestions are welcomed for two skill oriented certificate courses offered by the Dept. of English. The following two courses are suggested
 - (i) Content Writing
 - (ii) Training for English Language Trainers

Members of the Board enquired of the certification of these courses. It is also suggested to have MoUs with reputed institutions and these courses could be offered in collaboration with them.

The Chair Person of the U.G Board assured the members of the board that the observations pointed out would be considered and appropriate action would be taken in the next revision. The meeting came to an end at 10.45p.m.
