Elective – II: Post Colonial Literature -EN822C

- Suggested to replace the prose of Meenakshi Mukherji's "Interrogating Post colonialism" in unit II.
- To avoid the repetition, Manjula Padmanaban's *Harvest* in unit III could be replaced by other text.
- Unit –IV Short Stories titles clarity need to be ensured regarding the choice of the story from an anthology.
- Khaled Hosseini's *The Kite Runner* could be replaced with the works of Ceylon writer Shyam Sundhar.
















- Suggested to have publication of papers in ISSN journal as a part of a Unit.
