Resolutions and Suggestions

Reviewing the existing MSc counselling Psychology subjects and proposing subjects for the new curriculum

- Biological Psychology to be taught in the first semester as it is a base for counselling
- To bring Biological Psychology to the 1st Sem, Counselling Skills can be moved to 2nd Sem and Research Methodology can be moved to 3rd semester.
- Organizational Behaviour should be taught before Human Resource Management.
- Subject Behaviour Modification to be included (Behaviour Modification Approaches and Techniques).
- Organisational Behaviour and Human Resource Management can be removed and instead of that counselling based subjects to be included. eg: Family Counselling, Career Counselling, Behaviour modification etc
- Subject “Counselling for people with specific needs” can be taught.
- Can have employability skills as a certificate course.
- Thinking Skills can be taught as a subject in UG and PG level, it can be introduced as a skill paper.
- “Thinking Skill” can be replaced with a certificate course.

- More focus on helping and encouraging students to write research papers /publications/ paper presentations must be given.
- Psychopathology I and II could be converted into 1 paper.

It was decided that the faculty of the department would revise the subjects based on the proposals made during BoS meeting.

Reviewing the existing syllabus and proposing suggestions

It was decided that the faculty of the department would revise the syllabus based on the proposals made during the Academic Audit and present it during the next BoS meeting.

Reviewing and approving the I UG syllabus

- The Psychology core papers suggested by TANSICHE was approved.

There were proposals with regard to the Allied Paper 1 and 2 (Management)

- Managing behaviour in Organisation not necessary in 1st Semester, it can be interchanged with statistics in psychology. It can be introduced later.
- Developmental Psychology can be introduced in 1st Semester.
- Psychology in Advertising subject was felt out of place for psychology students as it is more towards marketing.
- Principles of Management and Organisational Behaviour was felt to be a better option for Allied Paper.
- Entrepreneurial Development and Business Communication were also suggested for allied subjects.
- To decide on Allied Subjects based on the availability of faculty of the Management dept who can handle the subject.

It was decided that the faculty of the department would revise the subjects based on the proposals made during BoS meeting.

Approving the Certificate course “Psychology of Interpersonal Relationship” for students from other departments

- All the members approved the certificate course “Psychology of Interpersonal Relationship”

A few topics were suggested to be included in the syllabus











- Write research papers and thus enhance their writing Skills.









- Coaching can be given to the students to take part in National Level examinations like UGC NET and JRF.
