FEED BACK ANALYSIS AND ACTION TAKEN REPORT

PG - 2020 – 2021

Feedback Analysis:

The following resolutions were discussed and implemented during the meeting. The syllabus of all PG courses has undergone a significant revision, with approximately 25 to 30% modifications. New papers have been introduced in the elective sections, this would broaden the scope of knowledge and enhance the learning experience for the PG students. Certain courses, such as spectroscopy and physical chemistry, have been strategically shifted to different semesters in order to meet the needs and progression of the students. In response to the evolving demands of the industry, the syllabus now places a strong emphasis on practical experience.

For first-year PG students, a summer internship is strongly recommended, while second-year PG students are required to undertake a mandatory project work to enhance their practical skills and industry exposure. In line with fostering a culture of continuous learning, students are encouraged to opt for NPTEL/SWAYAM/MOOC courses. These courses offer additional credits and serve as an avenue for students to gain supplementary knowledge beyond the regular curriculum.

Action Taken Report:

1. The revised syllabus has been successfully implemented across all PG courses.
2. The newly introduced elective papers have been integrated into the curriculum.
3. The rescheduling of courses, including the relocation of spectroscopy and physical chemistry, has been reflected in the academic calendar.
4. Guidelines for summer internships and project work for first and second-year PG students, respectively, have been circulated.
5. Information about the availability of NPTEL/SWAYAM/MOOC courses and their potential for earning extra credits has been disseminated among students. Guidance on the selection of courses and the credit transfer process has been provided.

We believe that these revisions and implementations will contribute positively to the academic and professional development of our PG students.
