This report is Annual Report that presents the activities whatever carried out from January 2022 to December 2022 by this project in the select schools of Level I. The Level I cover PUPS Choodapuram, PUPS PUPS Kothapalli, PUPS Itchangur, Thummanapalli, PUPS Venkatrayapuram, PUPS Sanasandhiram, PUPS Somanathapuram, PUPS Gudisathanapalli, PUPS Onnalavadi, PUPS Gollapalli, PUPS O. Karapalli, PUPS Mathigiri, PUPS Panchakshipuram, PUPS S. Mudhuganaplli, PUMS PUMS PUMS Nagondapalli, PUMS Thorapalli, Mugalapalli, Hanumanthapuram and PUMS Mugalur.

GENERAL MEDICAL CAMP



The General Medical Camp was conducted at 11 PUPS & 5 PUMS schools and it was held on August 1st& 2nd week. The camp was organized with Metro Hospital, Hosur. Dr. Deepthi with her team conducted the



camp. 477 students were screened.

WASH TRAINING

WASH training program was organized for children of level-I schools. There were 31 sessions conducted during this year. Sessions included personal hygiene like how to keep themselves clean, washing their hands on regular basis

and taking bath regularly. There were 820 children actively participated and benefited from the training programme.



NUTRITION SUPPLEMENTS

Knowing the need of the students, LOIP provided nutritious snacks to the students. The project records that, these snacks were made in a very hygienic manner without adding white sugar and making it completely out of grains and



cereals. The purpose of distributing nutritious snacks to children is to encourage children to attend school. Nutrient supplementary was provided to all the




students from Level-I for 131 days. As an outcome of the activity, the project believed that it would have motivated the students to come regularly to school; in fact, it could reduce the absentees and open a way for new enrollment.

REMEDIAL COACHING

The basic numeracy and literacy coaching was provided to all students (Level-I). The coaching held for nine months. These sessions were conducted by the RPs in their respective schools. Students learn Tables, Additions and Subtractions and improved upon reading and writing of Tamil language through this coaching.



MONTHLY TEST

Monthly test was conducted at the end of every month. It helped the students to understand their level and motivates them to make efforts for their improvement. The monthly test was started from the month of February to November. Students from Level-I benefited from this test.

ORGANIZING SMC MEETING

SMC meetings were organized from the month of March to November in PUMS Hanumanthapuram; PUMS Mugalapalli; PUMS Mugalur; PUMS Nagondapalli, PUMS Thorapalli; PUPS Choodapuram; PUPS Gollapalli; PUPS

Gudisathanapalli; PUPS Mathigiri; PUPS O Karapalli; PUPS Onnalvadi; PUPS Panchakshipuram; PUPS Mudhuganapalli; PUPS Sanasandiram; PUPS

HOME VISIT

RPs performed home visit twice in a week to know students'



learning difficulties and family environment. Visits found that children were at risk on their way to school. 4, 6, 4, and 6 visits made during the month of April, September,



October, and November respectively. Home visits helped RPs to understood the difficulties of students and their family situation.

PARENT CALL



RPs contacted the parents of students as and when required. Calls made to enquire student's general behavior in home, regularity in doing homework and in what way the child needs help. During this academic year, RPs made 98 calls to the parents of 98 students. 4,8,21,18,4,6, and 6 calls made in the month of March, April, July, August, September,



October, and November respectively. SCHOOL ANNUAL DAY CELEBRATIONS / ACADEMIC FEST

Academic Fest was held on 20th April at Students from PUPS Bagalur. Choodapuram, PUPS; Thummanapalli: PUPS Kothapalli; PUMS Mugalapalli; GHS Choodapuram; GHS Kothapalli and GBHSS Bagalur participated. The event was enriched by visit and participation of Schaeffler team, DEO, Government officials, HMs and parents. Students exhibited their skills. Event scholastic and co-scholastic included cultural activities performed by students. 10 stalls were put up by students with the guidance of RPs. 353 students participated and showcased their talents. Parents thanked and appreciated the project for creating an opportunity for students to show their talents. WELLNESS EDUCATION

Kindness, humility, courage, and compassion are built at an early age of human being by watching the videos.
