INTRODUCTION

Learning Outcome Improvement Project (LOIP) is a four-level operating project for development of Government school children in and around Hosur, Krishnagiri district of Tamilnadu. This report is an annual report that presents the activities whatever carried out from January 2022 to December 2022 by this project in the select schools of Level II. The Level II cover PUPS Choodapuram, PUPS Thummanapalli, PUPS Kothapalli, PUPS Itchangur, PUPS Venkatrayapuram, PUPS Sanasandhiram, PUPS Somanathapuram, PUPS Gudisathanapalli, PUPS Onnalavadi, PUPS Gollapalli, PUPS O. Karapalli, PUPS Mathigiri, PUPS Panchakshipuram, PUPS S. Mudhuganaplli, PUMS **PUMS** Nagondapalli, **PUMS PUMS** Thorapalli, Mugalapalli, Hanumanthapuram and PUMS Mugalur.

GENERAL MEDICAL CAMP

The General Medical Camp was conducted at 11 PUPS & 5 PUMS schools and it was held on August 1st & 2nd week. The camp was organized in collaboration with Metro Hospital, Hosur. Dr. Deepthi with her team conducted the camp. 858 students were screened from the medical camps



WASH TRAINING



The wash training program was organized for children of level-II schools. 31 sessions were There were conducted and **RPs** were educating children about



personal hygienic like how to keep themselves clean, to wash their hands on regular basis and to take bath. There were 1635 children actively participated and benefited from the training.

NUTRITION SUPPLEMENTARY

Knowing the need of the students, LOIP Project has been providing nutritious snacks to the students. Snacks were made in a very hygienic manner without

adding white sugar and making it completely out of grains and cereals. The purpose of distributing nutritious snacks to children is to encourage children to attend school. Nutrient supplementary was provided to all the students from Level II for 131 days. As an outcome of



the activity, the project believed that it would have motivated the students to come regularly to school; in fact, it could reduce the absentees and open a way for new enrollment.

NUTRITION EDUCATION



28 sessions were conducted on Nutrient Education in all schools covered by Level-II. 1558 were educated on nutrition. The aim of the Nutrition Education was to help the students to learn about the benefits of

taking Fruits and Vegetables as part of their food. RPs conducted sessions in the PUMS Hanumanthapuram, PUMS Mugalur, PUMS Nagondapalli, PUMS Thorapalli, PUMS Mugalapalli, PUPS Choodapuram, PUPS Thummanapalli, PUPS Gollapalli, PUPS Mathigiri, PUPS O Karapalli, PUPS onnalvadi, PUPS Panchashipuram, PUPS Mudhuganapalli, PUPS Sanasandhiram, PUPS Somanathapuram, PUPS Kothapalli, and PUPS Gudisathanapalli.

REMEDIAL COACHING AND MONTHLY TEST



Basic numeracy and literacy coaching was provided to all schools (Level II). The coaching was held for nine months. These sessions were conducted by the RPs in their respective schools. And through this coaching, the students learn Tables, Additions and Subtractions and improved upon reading and writing of Tamil language.

MONTHLY TEST

The monthly test was conducted at the end of every month. It helped the students to understand their level and motivates them to make efforts for their improvement.



Referral of Children with Learning Disability

RPs identified 6 children with learning disabilities. Two children had difficulty in writing and one child had difficulty in reading and speaking. (PUMS Hanumanathapuram- Thimaraju -5th std; PUPS Mudhuganapalli -Aravind -5th

std, Navin, sharmila-4th std; PUPS Panchashipuram –Mamatha 3rd std, Dhuraiarasan-2nd std.)

ORGANIZING SMC MEETING



74 SMC meetings were organized in PUMS Hanumanthapuram; PUMS Mugalapalli; PUMS Mugalur; PUMS Nagondapalli, PUMS Thorapalli; PUPS Choodapuram; PUPS Gollapalli;

PUPS Gudisathanapalli; PUPS Mathigiri; PUPS O Karapalli; PUPS Onnalvadi; PUPS Panchashipuram; PUPS Muduganapalli; PUPSSanasandiram; PUPS Somanathapuram; PUPS Thummanapalli; PUPS Itchagur; PUPS Kothapalli;

Discussion held on, increasing student strength and ensuring education to students, ensuring teacher-pupil ratio based on student strength, discussed about school infra with 5% share of School management, preparing school development plan and discuss about எண்ணும் எழுத்தும்.



HOME VISIT



58 Home visits were made twice in a week to know students learning difficulties and family environment. Children were found at risk on their way to school. In the month of March 6 visits, April 16 visits, September 12 visits, October 15 visits,



November 9 visits were made. RPs understood the difficulties of students and their family situation through home visits.

PARENT CALL

Parents of weak students were contacted through phone as and when required. Calls made to enquiry about student's general behavior in home, regularity in doing homework and in what way the child needs help. During this academic



year, RPs made 174 calls to the parents of 174 students. In the month of April 14 calls, July 32 calls, August 35 calls, September 34 calls, October 26 calls and November 33 calls were made. schools were educated on wellness. The show was screened once in a week for 30 minutes.

YOGA

146 Yoga sessions was conducted. 2629 Students learnt simple yoga exercises. LOIP believed that students would have learned the importance of yoga, body fitness and health.



KITCHEN GARDEN

Kitchen Gardens were established and maintained in 4schools (PUPS Mathigiri, PUPS S.Mudhuganaplli, PUPS Gollapalli and PUMS Nagondapalli).


School Kitchen gardens are good for learning: they are
