
INTRODUCTION

Present report is annual report that presents the activities whatever carried out from January 2022 to December 2022 by LOIP in the select schools of Level-III. The Level-III covers PUMS Hanumanthapuram, PUMS Mugalur, PUMS Mugalapalli, PUMS Nagondapalli, PUMS Thorapalli, GHS Onnalavadi, GHS Kothapalli, GHS Choodapuram, GBHSS Bagalur, GGHSS Bagalur, GHSS Mullainagar and GHSS Machinayakanapalli.

GENERAL MEDICAL CAMP

834 (Boys-503, Girls-331) students were screened and they identified 178 students with eye problems. Six eye camps were organized in 6 schools (PUMS -3, GHS -2 & GHHS- 1). Dr. Kalpana and her team from Vasan Eye Care conducted the camps. Camps held at PUMS Hanumanthapuram, GHHS Machinayakanapally, PUMSThorapalli & GHS Onnalavadi & GHS Choodapuram.





REPRODUCTIVE HEALTH EDUCATION

46 sessions were conducted on Reproductive health training. The aim of the Reproductive health education was to help the students to learn about adolescence changes in boys and girls. 340 students learnt about basic reproductive system of human being during this academic year.





WASH TRAINING PROGRAMME

1711 students were trained on WASH through 28 sessions. Children were educated on personal hygienic like how to keep themselves clean, washing their hands on regular basis and to take bath.





EDUCATION ON NUTRITION

29 sessions were conducted on Nutrition Education during this academic year. The aim of the Nutrition Education was to help the students to learn about the benefits of



consuming Fruits and Vegetables as part of their food. In the month of March, 9 sessions were conducted and 1711 students attended from 9 schools (PUMS



Hanumanthapuram, PUMS Mugalur, PUMS Mugalapalli, GHS Kothapalli, GHS Choodapuram, GBHSS Bagalur, GGHSS Bagalur, GHSS Mullainagar and GHSS Machinayakanapally). In the month of April, 8 sessions were conducted and 1279 students attended from 8 schools (PUMS Hanumanthapuram, PUMS Mugalur, PUMS Mugalapalli, GHS Kothapalli, GHS Choodapuram, GBHSS Bagalur, GHSS Mullainagar and GHSS Machinayakanapally). In the month of November, 12 sessions were conducted and 633 students attended from 10 schools (PUMSHanumanthapuram, PUMS Mugalur, PUMS Mugalapalli, PUMS Magondapalli, PUMS Thorapalli, GHS Kothapalli, GHS Sagalur, GHSS Mullainagar and GHSS Mugalapalli, PUMS Nagondapalli, PUMS Thorapalli, GHS Kothapalli, GHS Onnalavadi, GBHSS Bagalur, GHSS Mullainagar and GHSS Machinayakanapally).

ORGANIZING SMC MEETINGS

45 meetings were coordinated by LOIP in all Level – III schools. Discussion on LOIP project and its deliveries, increasing student strength and ensuring education to

students, ensuring teacher-pupil ratio based on student strength, discussed about the learning disabilities of the children, preparing school development plan and discussed about student education awareness and engaging parents, public, local heads with school activities were facilitated in

the meetings.

RPs visited the student's home twice a week and spoke about student's



learning difficulties, family environment. In the month of March, 11 visits; April, 20; September, 11 visits; October, 13 visits; November, 12 visits were made. Home visit made for the students who belong to PUMSHanumanthapuram, PUMS Mugalur, PUMS Mugalapalli, PUMS Nagondapalli, PUMS Thorapalli, GHS Onnalavadi, GHS Choodapuram, GHS Kothapalli, GBHSS



Bagalur, and GHSS Machinayakanapally and GHSS Mullainagar.

PARENT CALL



Parents (of student-in-need) were contacted on a monthly basis to enquiry about students' general behavior at home, regularity in doing homework and to know in what way the child can be helped. Totally, 188 parents call were made. In the month of March, 9 calls; April, 6 calls; June, 3 calls; July, 37 calls; August, 40; September, 35 calls; October, 21 calls; November, 27 calls were made for the students who belong to PUMS Hanumanthapuram, PUMS Mugalur, PUMS Mugalapalli, PUMS Nagondapalli, PUMS Thorapalli, GHS Onnalavadi, GHS Choodapuram, GHS Kothapalli, GBHSS Bagalur, GHSS

Machinayakanapalli and GHSS Mullainagar.

MEETING PARENTS IN THE COMMUNITY

There were 9 meetings held in the community. In the month of **March** 3 meetings were conducted, 20 parents of the students from GHSS



Machinayakanapalli, 1 0 parents of students from GHS Kothapalli,



18 parents of students from PUMS Hanumanthapuram participated in the meeting. In the month of April one meeting was conducted, 5 parents of the students from GHS Choodapuram participated in the meetings. In the

month of October 5 meetings was conducted, 20 parents of the students from PUMS

Thorapalli, 23 parents of the students from PUMS Mugalapalli, 48 parents of the students from PUMS Mugalur, 23 parents of the students from PUMS Nagondapalli and 17 parents of the students from PUMS Hanumanthapuram participated in the parents meetings.

CAPACITY BUILDING PROGRAMMES

As presented in the Level-I & II report, for level-III also same as the training programme includes RPs from level -I, II & III.

ANNUALDAYCELEBRATION/ACADEMICFEST

Academic fest was held at Government Boys Hr. Sec School, Bagalur. 350 students participated and exhibited during the fest. PUPS Choodapuram, PUPS Thummnapalli, PUPS Kothapalli, PUMS Mugalapalli, GHS Choodapuram, GHS Kothapalli and GBHSS Bagalur schools participated.

ACADEMIC FEST SCHOOL LEVEL

Academic fest was held at school Level also. Our RPs helped The students to show their talents in scholastic and co-scholastic activities, there were around 50 activities done by each school. 220 students from PUMS Mugalur exhibited their



talents on 28-03-2022. 40 students from PUPS Somanathapuram exhibited their talents on 28-03-2022. 410 students from GHSS Mullai Nagar exhibited their talents on 29-04-2022.

INTRODUCTIONTOYOGA

Yoga class was conducted once in a week. Totally, 1711 students from 9 schools (PUMS Hanumanthapuram, PUMS Mugalur, PUMS Mugalapalli, GHS Kothapalli, GHS Choodapuram, GBHSS Bagalur, GGHS SBagalur, GHS S Mullai Nagar and GHSS Machinayakanapalli) learnt yoga exercises.



DAILY EXERCISES

The goal of daily exercise is to facilitate students to keep their body fit physically. 1711 students from 9 schools (PUMS Hanumanthapuram, PUMSMugalur, PUMS Mugalapalli, GHS Kothapalli, GHS Choodapuram, GBHSS Bagalur, GGHSS Bagalur, GHSS Mullainagarand, GHSS Machinayakanapalli) participated and learnt daily exercises.

LIFESKILLS & CIVIC/CITIZENSHIPEDUCATION

Sessions on life skills & civic / citizenship education was held for Level-III students. Sessions helped the students to learn how to overcome problems. Life skill of students from class-VIII was assessed. Totally, 11 sessions were organized. There were 214 students from PUMS Hanumanthapuram,



PUMS Mugalur, PUMS Nagondapalli, PUMS Thorapalli, PUMS Mugalapalli, GHS Kothapalli, GHS Choodapuram, GHS Onnalvadi, GHSS Machinayakanapalli, GBHSS Bagalur, and GHSS Mullainagar actively attended the session. Sessions were conducted by Mr.Gilbert, Department of Life Education, Sacred Heart College(Autonomous), Tirupattur.

KITCHEN GARDEN



Kitchen Gardens were established and maintained in 7 schools (PUMS Thorapalli, PUMS Nagondapalli, GHS Onnalavadi, GHS Kothapalli,



GHSS Mullainagar, GHSS Machinayakanapally and GBHSS Bagalur).

HERBAL GARDEN

Herbal Gardens were established and maintained in 8 schools (PUMS Nagondapalli, PUMS Mugalur, PUMS Mugalapalli, PUMS Thorapalli, PUMS Hanumanthapuram, GHS Onnalavadi, GHSS Machinayakanapalliand GHSS Mullainagar).





PROVISION OF SPORTS MATERIAL

Sports materials were distributed to 11 schools of Level – III. Students were happy to receive the sports materials and they enjoyed while playing by using our sports kit. HMs and students thanked Sacred Heart College Society and SCHAEFFLER.



10 intra-school sports meet were organized. Totally 6728 students from (PUMS Hanumanthapuram, PUMS Mugalur, PUMS Mugalapalli, PUMS Nagondapalli, PUMS Thorapalli, GHS Onnalavadi, GHS





Kothapalli, GHS Choodapuram, GHSS Machinayakanapalli, GBHSS Bagalur and GHSS Mullainagar) participated expressed their sports talents. Events like 100mts, 200mts, 400mts, 800mts, Long Jump, High Jump, Shot Put and Relay were included in the sports meet.

INTER SCHOOL SPORTS EVENT

Inter School sports meet was organized at Adhiyaman Engineering College, Hosur. 170 students from Level – III schools participated in the sport meet. It was conducted in 2 categories (U-13 & U-15) boys and girls separately. The 1st, 2nd, 3rd place winners were awarded with medals and certificates.



NMMS EXAM

The National Means Cum-Merit Scholarship (NMMS) is a competitive exam for

scholarship. Awareness program orientation session was organized to Level-III students of LOIP Schools (PUMS Hanumanthapuram, GGHSS Bagalur, PUMS Mugalur, PUMS Mugalapalli, GHS Kothapalli, GHS Choodapuram, GHSS Machinayakanapalli, GBHSS Bagalur, GHSS Mullainagar). 34 students appeared in the exams and 2 students (from Govt. Hr. Sec. School, Mullai Nagar) got through the exam.





REMEDIAL COACHING

The basic numeracy and literacy coaching class were organized from January to December. 353 students were given remedial coaching.





Identification & Referral of children with learning disability

Children with Learning Disability children were identified. Totally 12 children were identified. Two children had difficulty in writing and a child had difficulty in reading and speaking. GHS Kothapalli- Hemanthkuamr, Nikil & Ramakrishana – 7th Std; GHSS Mullainagar – Punith, Vasanth, PavanKumar – 7th Std; PUMS Mugalur – Chaithra- 7th Std; PUMS Hanumanthapuram - Madhu- 6th Std, Thilak - 7th Std; GBHSS Bagalur – Sagar- 6th Std, Nandha Kishore, Govindharaj -7th Std

SPOKEN ENGLISH COACHING

Considering the importance of the Spoken English, LOIP introduced spoken English classes to Students at Level-III also. Coaching was given to all students of Level – III schools.



SCOUTS AND GUIDES TRAINING

Sessions on Scouts and Guides was organized in PUMS Mugalapalli for Level – III students (Class- VI to Class – VIII only). Trainers teach the students about motto, promise, law, march fast and flag song. Personality development related games were conducted. Students were actively participated and enjoyed the training session. Students were well trained to perform on republic day celebration.





CHILDREN CARNIVAL / TALENT MELA

Children carnival was organized in all LOIP Project schools. Totally 386 Students participated and showcased their talents. 1st, 2nd & 3rd place winners were awarded them with Medals and certificates. Carnival helped the students to develop their skills and enhance their learning abilities.,





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
