INTRODUCTION

Learning Outcome Improvement Project (LOIP) is a Four Level operating project for development of government school children in and around Hosur, Krishnagiri district of TamilNadu. This report is annual report that presents the activities whatever carried out from January 2022 to December 2022 by this project in the select schools of Level-IV. The Level-IV covers GHS Onnalavadi, GHS Kothapalli, GHS Choodapuram, GBHSS Bagalur, GGHSS Bagalur, GHSS Mullainagar and GHSS Machinayakanapalli.

GENERAL MEDICAL CAMP

Eye camps were organized in 3 schools (GHS -2 & GHSS- 1). The first camp was organized at GHSS Machinayakanapally. Dr. Kalpana and her team conducted the camp. The camp also was conducted in GHS Onnalavadi & GHS Choodapuram. From this camp totally 350 students benefited from 3 schools and they identified 152 students with eye issues. All schools HMs, teachers & parents were happy and appreciated for organizing such useful camps for students.



TRAINING PROGRAMME ON REPRODUCTIVE HEALTH

There were 7 sessions conducted on Reproductive health during this project period. The aim of the training was to help the students to learn about the



changes in boys and girls during their adolescence period. The respective RPs conducted the sessions. In the month of August, 4 sessions were conducted and 67 students from 3 schools (GHS Choodapuram, GHSS Mullainagar and GHSS



Machinayakanapalli) participated in the training. In the month of September, 2 sessions were conducted and 136 students from 2 schools (GHS Kothapalli and GHSS Mullainagar) participated in the training. In the month

of October, 1 session was conducted and 30 students from GHS Onnalavadi participated in the training.

ORGANISING SMC MEETINGS



During the project period, SMC meetings were organized in the following schools (GHS Kothapalli, GHS Choodapuram, GHS Onnalavadi, GBHSS Bagalur, GHSS Mullainagar and GHSS

Machinayakanapally). The discussion of the SMC meeting were on increasing the student strength, ensuring quality education to students, ensuring teacher-pupil ratio based on student strength, School infra with 5% contribution, and School developmental activities.



HOMEVISIT

RPs have performed home visit twice in a week to know students learning difficulties and family environment.



During the period of one year, 13 home visits were made for the students from GHS Kothapalli, GHS Onnalavadi, GHS Choodapuram, GBHSS Bagalur, GHSS Mullainagar and GHSS Machinayakanapalli.

PARENT CALL

RP called the parents of school students (in-need) on a monthly basis to find out the students' academic activities and behavior at home. During this progress period, parents of Kurumoorthy, Shrihari, Balaj Nithin Kumar, Yeswanth Raj, Kaviya, Sriram, supreth, Nagaraj, Bharath, Chandru, Manjunath, Mamatha, Madeveppa L. Indu.G, Tharun, Poorna Chandrika, Priya M, Chethan M, Mani, Pavankumar, Adthiya G, Kaviya A, Charan, Many shree S, Adithya G and Srihari M were contacted and these students are studying in GHSS Mullainagar, GBHSS Bagalur and GHSS Machinayakanapalli.



MEETING PARENTS IN THE COMMUNITY

Parents meeting were held thrice in the community. 20 parents of students from GHSS Machinayakanapalli, 10 parents of students from GHS Kothapalli and 5 parents of students from GHS Choodapuram participated in the meeting. RP Mrs. Agila, RP Mrs. Brylin Jeya Babel & RPs Mrs. Stella Mary & Ms. Sandhya organized the meetings. In the meeting RPs discussed the issues and needs of the children.



CAPACITY BUILDING PROGRAMMES TO RESOURCE PERSONS

A training programme on Project management for RPs was held at Navadhi Office on 03-03-2022 & 04-03-2022. 20 RPs and 1 MIS participated in the training. Mrs. Mary Sujatha, Project Manager conducted the training program.



'Identifying and redressing the learning difficulties among children', a capacity building program to Project Resource Person was held on 12/04/2022 at Peppermint Hotel-Hosur. The training program was conducted by Rev.Fr.

Joseph Jeyaraj and his team members. This program mainly focused on students who has learning difficulties and psychological problem, way to identify the children with fear and some methods to help them to come out from their fear.



A capacity building program on TLM was held on 01/06/2022 at Navadhi office. 20 RPs and 1 MIS were participated in the training program.



On 02-06-2022, Boot camp Activities was held at Navadhi Office. 20 RPs and 1 MIS participated in the training program. Mrs. Mary Sujatha, Project Manager, conducted the training program. On 06-06-2022, a training programme on Record Maintenance was held at Navadhi Office. 19 RPs and 1 MIS

On 09-06- 2022, a training programme on Time Management was held at Navadhi Office. 20 RPs and 1 MIS participated in the training program. Mrs. Mary Sujatha, Project Manager conducted the training program. On 15-06-2022, a seminar on Child Protection Policy was held at Navadhi Office. 20 RPs and 1 MIS participated in the training program. Mrs.

Mary Sujatha, Project Manager conducted the training program. The Capacity building program on Spoken English was held on 18/06/2022. This program was conducted by Rev.Fr. Maria Arokiya Raj, Mr. Einstein and Mrs. Thirunirai. The training helped RPs to enhance their knowledge in English. A Training programme was



organized on Reproductive Health on 30/07/2022.



The training was conducted by Dr.Neha and Mrs. Bhagalakshmi. This training is mainly focused on important of adolescent education and to create awareness and knowledge to students about the

changes in girls and boys during adolescent period.

SCHOOL ANNUAL DAY CELEBRATIONS / ACADEMIC FEST

Academic Fest was held on 20th April at Bagalur. It was one of the major event organized by LOIP in Bagalur. Govt. Boys Hr. Sec School was identified as CRC for the event which covered PUPS Choodapuram, PUPS; Thummanapalli; PUPS Kothapalli; PUMS Mugalapalli; GHS Choodapuram; GHS Kothapalli and GBHSS Bagalur. The event was enriched by the visits and participation of Schaeffler team, DEO, Government



officials, HMs, parents and students. Students exhibited their scholastic and co-scholastic skills. Event included cultural activities by students. 10 stalls were made by students with the guidance of RPs. 353



students participated and showcased their talents. It was fun filled day for the students. Best student awards were given to remedial students who performed well in their studies. Each participating schools performed around 50 activities on the day.

Parents thanked and appreciated the project as it created opportunity for students to show their talents. Similarly, Scholastic and co-scholastic related programs were performed by students on 29-04-2022 at GHSS Mullai Nagar. 410 students participated in the program. Irrespective project levels, students were participated and benefited from the academic fest.



YOGA (ONLY FOR CLASS – 9)

It is an art and science of healthy living. In the month of March 11 Yoga sessions was organized and 2842 Students participated. In the month of April, 28Yoga sessions were conducted and 2037 students were participated from

GHS Kothapalli, GHS Choodapuram, GBHSS Bagalur, GHSS Mullainagar and GHSS Machinayakanapalli. In the month of January-2023, 8 Yoga sessions were conducted and 205 students participated. RPs conducted the sessions. Various basic exercises of yoga were taught to the students.



KITCHEN GARDEN

School Kitchen gardens are good for learning. They are highly practical and a direct form of education, where students can learn how to grow good food, which not only improves health, but also provides opportunities for livelihood and increased self-sufficiency. Apart from practical skills in agriculture and horticulture, gardens are a living laboratory for the study of environment issues and life sciences. Kitchen Gardens were established and maintained in 5 schools (GHS Kothapalli, GHS Onnalavadi, GHSS Mullainagar, GHSS Machinayakanapalli and GBHSS Bagalur).



HERBAL GARDEN

The aim of the Herbal Garden is to educate students to identify different types of herbs and their uses, To inculcate sensitivity and awareness towards conservation of nature from a young age. Herbal Gardens were establishment and maintained in 3schools (GHS Onnalavadi, GHSS Mullainagar and GHSS Machinayakanapalli).



REFERRAL OF STUDENTS WHO ASPIRE SPORTS AS CAREER AND PROVISION OF SPORTS MATERIAL

During the academic year 2022, Sports aspirant Students were identified in Athletic discipline.

The identified students were, Aliya Taj (9th std, GHSS Mullai Nagar), Yukesh (12thstd, GHSS Mullai Nagar), Gowtham (10thstd, GHS Kothapalli) and for High Jump, Aravindhan

(12thstd, GBHSS Bagalur). These students were identified through intra-school sport meet and referred to district sports authority.

In the month of August, sports materials were provided to 6 schools in level 4. The school head masters received the sports material. Students were happy to receive the sports materials and they enjoyed while playing by

using our sports kit. HMs and students thanked Sacred Heart College Society and SCHAEFFLER.



INTER SCHOOL SPORTS EVENT

Inter School sports meet was organized at Adhiyaman Engineering College, Hosur. Mr. Muniraj DEO, Fr. James, Fr. Samson, Mr. Selvam, Mr. Bento Devaraj, Fr. Edward Michael SDB, Mrs. K. Prabhavathi, Sr. Anjela Ms. Jayanthi were present as guests for event.

112 students were participated in the meet.

The meet was organized by 2 categories such as U-15 and U-17 for boys and girls separately. 1st, 2nd and 3rd place winners were awarded with medals and certificates by category



REMEDIAL COACHING

326 students were given remedial coaching during this project period. Remedial coaching were given to

students from GBHSS Bagalur & GHSS Machinayakanapalli. RPs of respective schools was organizing the coaching class and 855 Remedial Hours were covered for the slow learners.



AWARENESS PROGRAMME - NTSE & TRUST EXAMS

The National Talent Search Exam (NTSE) and Tamilnadu Rural Students Talent Search Examination (TRUST) is a competitive exam for scholarship. It is

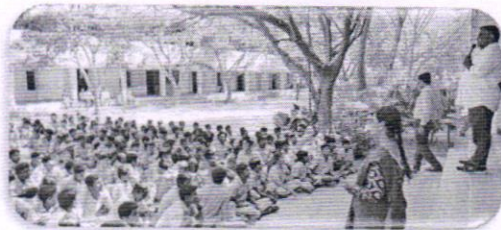


conducted by Government of India and Tamilnadu State Government every year. An orientation session was organized to students of Class-XI and Class-XII of LOIP Schools (GHSS Machinayakanapalli and GBHSS Bagalur). These sessions helped to identify and enhance the skills, logical reasoning and mental ability of students. The Session was conducted by Fr. Samson from Sacred Heart College on 19-01-2023. Fr. Samson gave a clear explanation to the



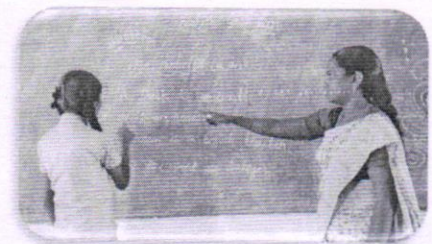
students about NTSE and TRUST exam and what benefit the students would get from writing the exam. In this session, he clearly explained to the students which topics to study for the exam, and also

explained how much incentive they will get by clearing this exam (XI and XII students will get Rs-1250 per month for NTSE Exam and Rs-1000 per month for TRUST Exam) and motivated the students to appear for this exam. There were totally 300 students from GBHSS Bagalur and 93 students from GHSS Machinayakanapally and 14 Government Teachers participated in the session.



SPOKEN ENGLISH

Weekly 4 sessions of spoken classes were organized in the schools. In the month of March, 60 sessions were conducted and 2842 students participated in these sessions. In the month of April, 14 sessions were organized and 2037 students participated. In the month of October, 5 sessions were conducted and 225



students participated in these sessions. In the month November, 3 sessions were organized and 45 students participated. In the month of January-2023, 8 sessions were conducted and 203 students participated. Students from GHS Kothapalli, GHS Choodapuram, GHSS Machinayakanapalli, GBHSS Bagalur and GHSS Mullainagar benefited from the Spoken English Classes.

COMPUTERLITERACYI-FUNDAMENTALS

In the month of April, computer Literacy program was organized at Govt. Higher Secondary Schools.

In the month of April RPs took 5 sessions and 2037 students were



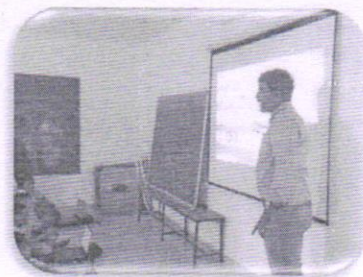

In the month of April, computer Literacy - II was organized. The program included 5 sessions and 2037 students were participated from GHS Kothapalli, GHS Choodapuram, GHSS Machinayakanapalli, GBHSS Bagalur



and GHSS Mullainagar.


CAREER GUIDANCE

Career Guidance and Counselling Program were offered to 10th and 12th students of Level-IV schools. In the month of April, 15 sessions were organized in their respective schools and 2007 students obtained the service on career guidance and counseling.



INFRA DEVELOPMENT

The LOIP facilitated the schools in developing some of its infrastructure facility. Resource Center has been established in GHSS Mullai Nagar. Resource Center is being useful for organizing zonal level teachers' meeting, special orientation to students and for exhibiting students' talents and Water and toilet facilities have been renovated in GHS Choodapuram. Renovating toilet facility was really helped students for their personal needs. Particularly for girl students this facility was the need of the hour. These infra developmental activities were carried out with 5% contribution of school management.
