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1. Installation and Roles and functions of Eco-club

After that the seed balls are allowed to dry overnight and given to students to throw nearby lake and other areas where there is need.



3. Benefits of Native Trees and Tropical Forests:

A Talk on "Benefits of Native Trees and Tropical Forests" was held on 28th September 2022 at Pope Francis Hall by 2.00 pm. The Prof. Mario in his talk explained about tropical rain forest first and elaborated about the benefits of native trees. 6. Workshop on BIRD WATCHING

The Workshop on Bird Watching was held on 11th February, 2023. The workshop was jointly organized by Tamil Birders, Don Bosco Green Alliance, PG & Research Department of Social Work, Department of Extension Education and Services, Eco-Club, Sacred Heart College.



The workshop aimed to educate the youth on the importance of birds for sustainable environment and the ways to preserve and promote birds. The workshop has created a way for initiating 'Tirupathur Birders Movement'.

The sessions were activity based, which included aspects like: life cycle of birds, challenges of birds, knowing the types of birds, methods to identify birds" existence, techniques to document the data and photos of birds and online portals for data driven bird count.Rev.Fr. John Alexander, Rector and Secretary, Rev. Fr, Andrews Raja, Head, P.G & Research Dept. of Social Work, Rev.Fr. Henry Daniel Ambrose, Director, Department of Extension Education and Services were present and inaugurated the workshop. Rev. Dr. John Alexander highlighted the initiatives of Sacred Heart College to educate youth to love and care for the nature. Dr. P. Jeganathan, Ms. Angeline Mano, Mr. S. V. Ganeshwar, Ms. V. Kirubhanandhini, Mr. K. Selvaganesh and Mr. Siva kumar from Tamil Birders served as resource persons. About 126 youth actively participated. Eco-audit of native trees in campus:



The Eco-audit of native trees in campus is done by 20 students of two teams on 17th February 2023. The findings are tabulated and the percentage of green cover are noted. The Caesalpinioideae species native to Madagascar, Terminalia catappa species which also belongs to Australia and pacific are quite in number. The diversity of Indian species like Millettia pinnata, Azadirachta indica, Tamarindus indica are large in number and some rare species like Santalum album, Terminalia arjuna, Borassus flabellifer are planted in last 5 years. The report concludes with inclusion of trees from Asian region to be planted.

1. Talk on organic farming:

A talk on organic farming and its benefits was held on 20th of February 2023. The benefits and methods of organic farming are made aware to students. The main aim of this talk is to promote organic farming and to also seed the rationale for upcoming certificate course on Organic farming from shift-1 department of chemistry.
