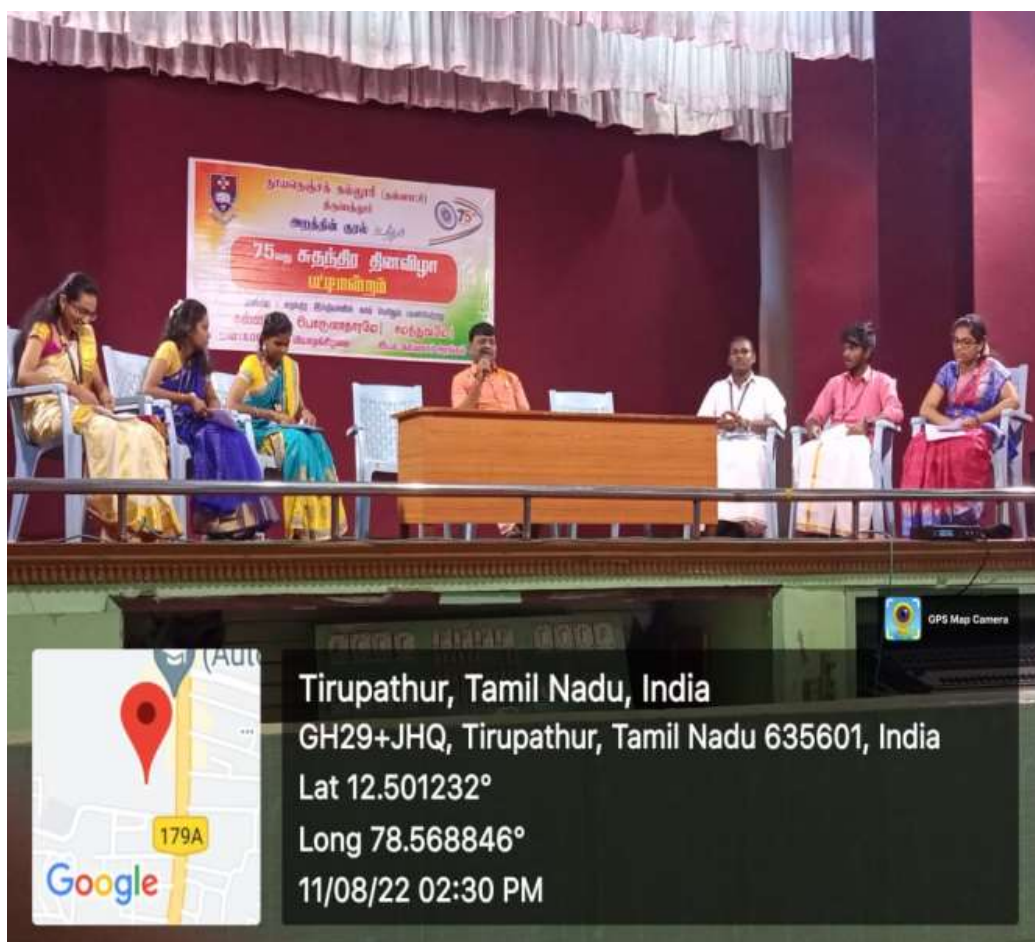

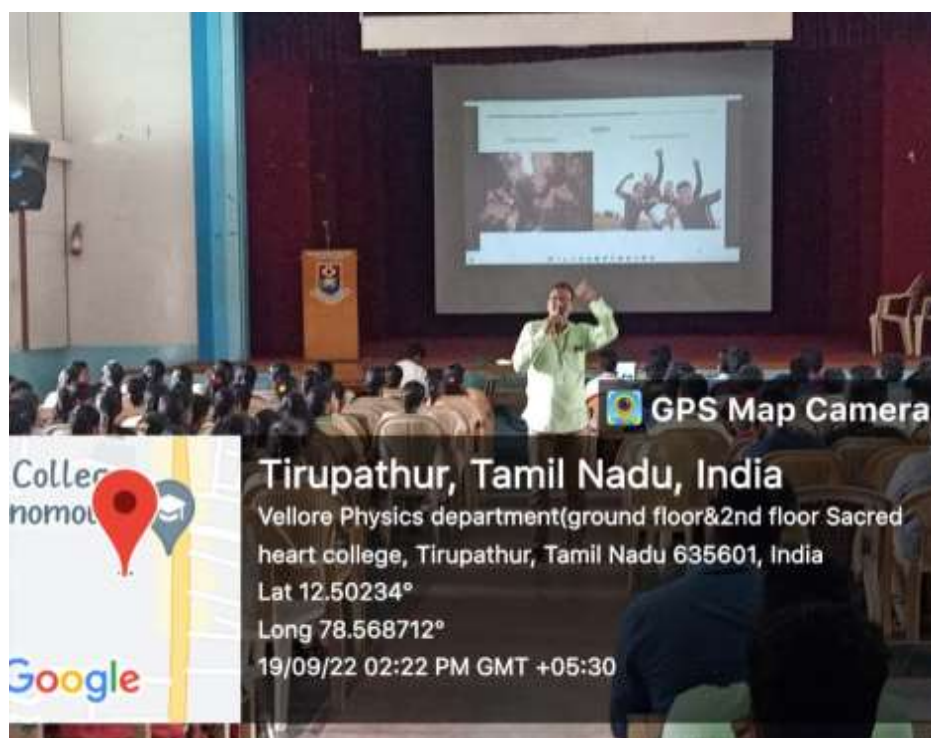
3.Awareness Program on the Eastern Ghats and Its Elephant Habitation


7. World AIDS Day' 2022- Oath

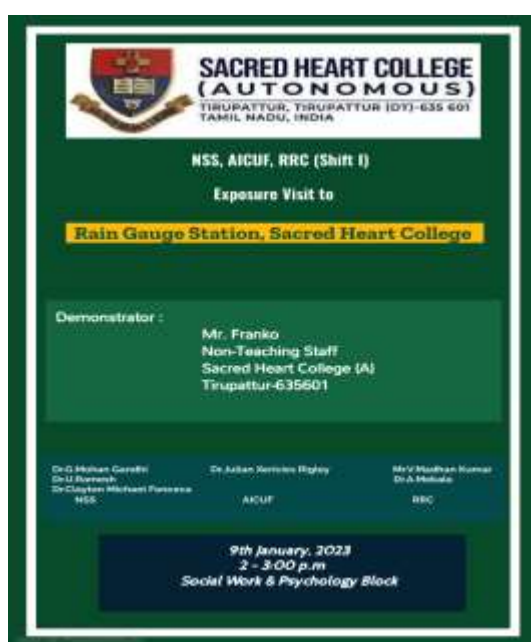




