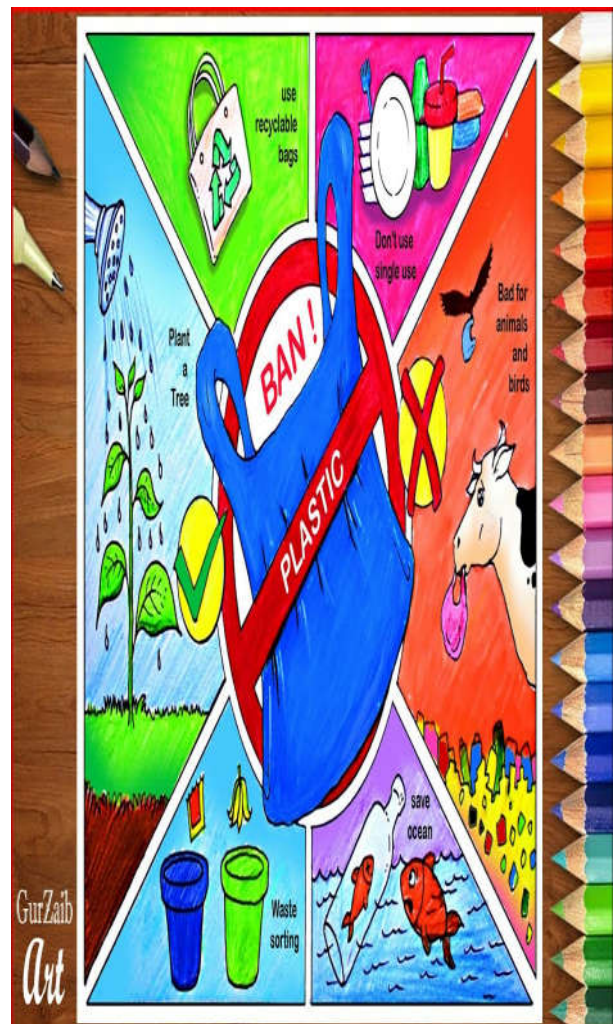
Awareness Talk on “International Day of Awareness of Food Loss and Food Waste” 29.09.2022

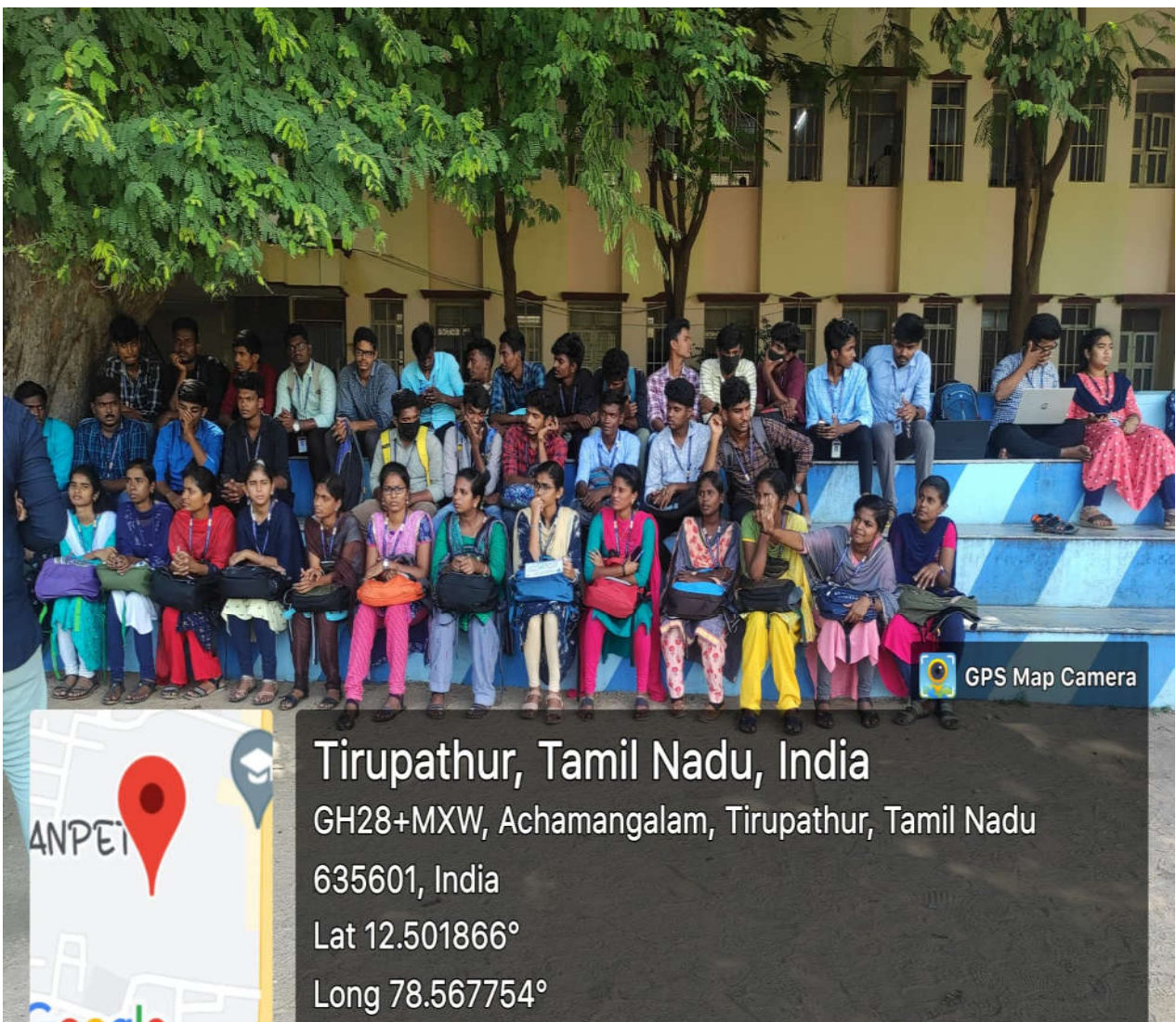
E-Poster Competition on “Eradication of Plastics” 29.01.2023
