4.4.2 There are established systems and procedures for maintaining and utilizing physical and academic support facilities – laboratory, library, sports complex, computers, classrooms etc.

Cleaning and Maintenance

The Sacred Heart College campus is well known for its cleanliness. The strategy followed for maintaining cleanliness is very systematic. Disposal dustbins for biodegradable and non-biodegradable wastes are kept at various points within the campus. Everyday a team of workers called as the “Dream Team” collect the waste from these dustbins and dump them behind the Don Bosco Indoor Stadium (DBIS). Around 6 ladies are employed to segregate them into biodegradable and non-biodegradable wastes and pack them separately. People from municipality come to collect the segregated wastes around 3pm every day.

There are 4 people in Alumni Café to clean and maintain it. Every morning around 8.00 am they open it, start the cleaning process and ensure the neatness of the Alumni café. The alumni café wastes are dumped in the nearby dust bins placed by the Sacred Heart College management.

The college canteen (Savio Café) has totally 7 Ladies and 4 Men for the maintenance and running. Especially three ladies are employed mainly for cleaning purpose and the cleanliness of the canteen is ensured now and then. The canteen wastes are disposed separately. The canteen management has a tie-up with municipality who come over here every alternate day around 5 pm to collect the wastes from the canteen. The canteen management pays around Rs.300 per visit for the municipality people.

There are several laboratories like Physics Lab, Chemistry Lab, Zoology Lab, Micro-biology and Biochemistry lab, etc. All the laboratories are cleaned and maintained by the respective Lab attenders available over there. The chemistry lab has 3 attenders for UG programmes and 2 attenders

for PG programmes. The zoology lab has 1 lady staff as attender who maintains the cleanliness and smooth functioning of the lab. The Micro-biology and Biochemistry lab has totally 4 attenders (3 men and 1 lady). The physics laboratory has 3 attenders for UG programmes and 2 attenders for PG programmes. Every morning, the attenders clean the laboratory and ensure the proper working of the instruments. The attenders try to rectify the minor faults like soldering, loose connections, null adjustments in meters, etc.
