1. Annual Alumni Day 2020

2. Executive Committee Meetings

11. 100 KG of Sugar was provided to the District Collectorate towards their services
12. 71 Families of Bonded Labourers from the villages of Agaram, T. Krishnapuram, Pallavalli Village, Irunapattu, Sowdekuppam, Kakanapalayam and Korati were given with the package at their own residence.
13. 8 Families of Cleaning workers at Ward 1, Tirupattur Municipality.
14. 45 HIV Positive and affected Families at Asriyar Nagar, Ananda patti
15. 18 HIV Positive and affected families at Andiyappanur HIV
16. Financial support for the establishment of Sidha Center through District Collector
17. 20 Families at Tirupattur Parish
18. Apart from that 52 SHC – NSS Volunteers and Transgender persons were given with T-Shirts to serve better with identity as volunteers.

In total 493 families were supported with the financial help of our alumni and well wishers through Alumni Association.

4. Scholarships Awarded:

The Alumni Association Executive Committee members contributed to support two poor students of Sacred Heart College with the educational scholarship in this academic year.


5. Strenna Presentation and Annual Planning for the year 2021:
