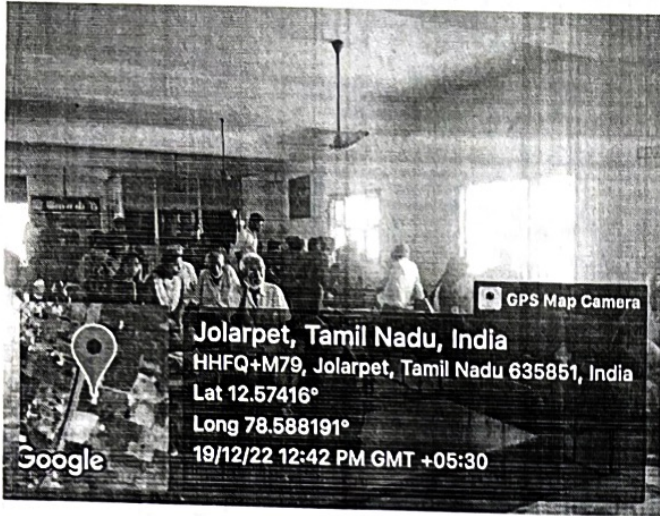
Then, the students performs some cultural events like singing, dance and playing musical instruments to entertain the aged peoples.

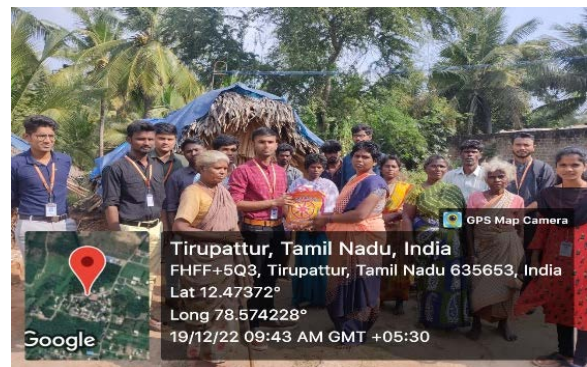


Sharing day with Irrular community
