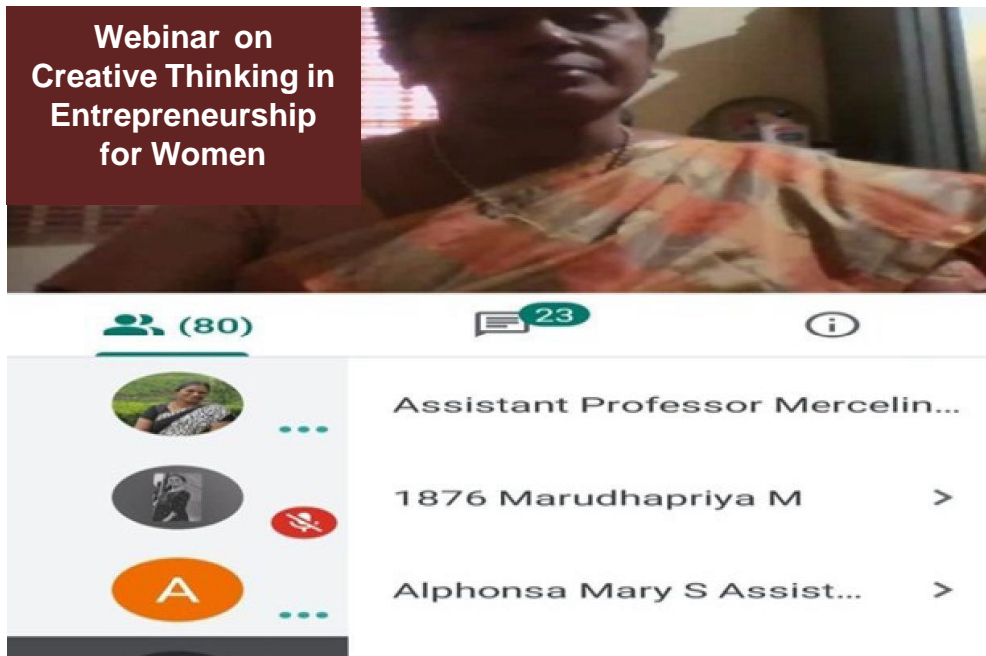

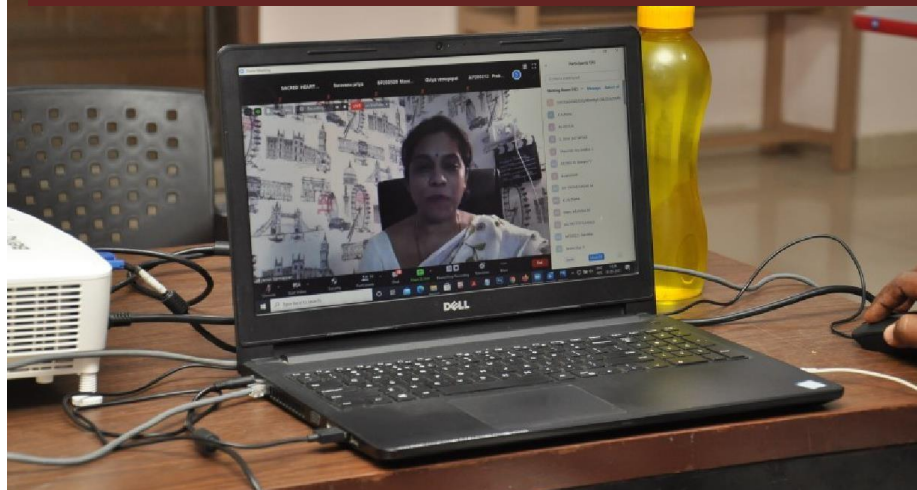
The International Women's Day by AICTE Women's Cell
