### **ANTI-HUMAN TRAFFICKING DAY**





# Women's Meet - 17 Sep 2022


### Report

The resource person for the Event was Dr.N.Madhu Priya MBBS,DGO,MS(OG)MRCOG. Dr.A.C.Gomathi, PG Head, Department of Biochemistry (Shift -I) introduced our honourable chief guest. Dr.S.R.Xavier Rajarathinam, Vice-Principal (Academics Shift - I), Head, Department of Chemistry, Honoured our Chief guest with a Momento. Dr. A. Merceline Anitha, Dean of Women Students, Assistant professor in Mathematics (Shift-I) Honoured our chief guest with Golden Shawl. Dr. K. Amala, Assistant Professor in Microbiology (Shift -I) Honoured our chief guest with Book. In her address, she elaborated on Cervical Cancer. Cervical cancer is the type of cancer that occurs in the cells of the cervix. Various strains of the Human Papilloma Virus, sexually transmitted infections that play a vital role in causing most cervical cancer stages. When exposed to HPV, the body's immune system typically prevents the virus from doing harm. In a small percentage of people, however, the virus survives for years, contributing to the processes that cause some cervical cells to become cancer cells. She also explained about the stages of HPV infection, Warning signs of Invasive cervical cancer, Prevention through vaccines and disease diagnosis. She also added that the condition is prevailing currently at the rate one out of five females under Reproductive age. This is the leading cause for the Infertility in Women. This programme was useful and informative for all the women students and women faculty. The faculty members and Students of Microbiology and Biochemistry Department graced the occasion with a special vote of thanks. Finally, the programme ended National Anthem.


# International Women's Day Competitions (2022-23)
