1. <u>Internship Programme for France Students</u>

PG Department of Computer Applications 9th July, 2018 to 27th July, 2018

The PG Department of Computer Applications organized a three week Internship Programme for Students from Institut de lemonier, Caen, France. This is the second Internship Programme conducted for the France students since 2017. This year six students participated in the internship. It was scheduled from 9th July, 2018 to 27th July, 2018. The key focus of the internship was to train the students in the latest trends in .Net, Java and ERP Technologies. The students were given a hands-on training which was augmented with a short term project. The course was coordinated by the Head, Mr.A.George Louis Raja and was carried out by Mr.P.Sugumar, Mr.S.Anthony Philomenraj, Mrs.C.Dharmadevi and Mrs.M.Poovizhi. Certificates were given to the students.







2. Workshop on Theatrics

Department of English (Shift-II) 9th to 13th, July, 2018.

The Department of English Shift-II in association with Mattru Nadaga Iyakam conducted a workshop on Theatrics between 9th to 13th july. The workshop was coordinated by Mr. S.Prabhakaran, Asst. Professor. Dr.G.Gopi from Pondicherry University was invited as the resource person. Dr.K.Parthibaraja, Assistant Professor, Department of Tamil (Shift – I), President, MNI, was also present. Dr.G.Gopi presented the dynamics of the workshop and its purpose. He gave a brief introduction about theatrics and skills involved in it. Dr.K.Parthibaraja gave a talk on drama. Practical exercises and tasks were given in order to develop the theatrical skills among the students. On the second day of the workshop, games were conducted by Dr.G.Gopi. Participants were divided into groups and trained to enact mimes on the given concepts. On the third day, Dr.G.Gopi taught the students on the effective way of using properties. Two groups were formed and games were conducted to test the interest and attentiveness of the participants. Tasks were given to develop the vocal skills. On the fourth day Ms.Melodi,

trainer from the National School of Drama, Delhi joined the workshop. The participants were asked to present some general information about the authors and their works from literature. Participants were divided into six groups and asked to enact dramas by using the given properties. On the fifth day the participants were divided into two groups and

given practice for effective performance. They enacted Nissim Ezekiel's poem *The Night of the Scorpion* in two separate groups.


20. Webinar on Creative Thinking in Entrepreneurship for Women


